We encourage all our guests to be responsible visitors. See our ten tips below:

1. Reduce energy wastage by switching off unnecessary lights and unplug electrical appliances when they are not in use.
2. Leave your car behind and walk, cycle or car pool instead. Ask at Reception for details on public transport, or see our website for more details.
3. Use local products wherever possible, they help support the local community as well as reducing food miles.
4. Try to avoid overly packaged goods.
5. Say no to that extra carrier bag and use a 'bag for life' instead.
6. Turn off the tap when you're brushing your teeth and take a shower instead of a bath. Reduce the amount of towels you use, see our towel policy for more information.
7. Have a positive impact on the environment, plant native flowers and trees in your garden.
8. Save trees and reduce pollution by using both sides of the paper. Use 100% post-consumer waste content paper whenever possible.
9. Recycle computer discs, CD's, videos and batteries. Use rechargeable batteries.
10. Participate in the Earth Hour annual event and turn your lights off for an hour on the designated day.
