**Samui Aquarium**

Please say "hello" to our Royal Tigers and young leopards. Guests may enjoy watching these magnificent animals, playing with one another and relaxing in the natural surroundings.

In Samui Aquarium guests will explore diversity kinds of fishes and undersea creatures from the Gulf of Thailand, especially in Koh Samui.

**Elephant Trekking at Namuang Waterfall**

**Ang Thong Marine National Park**

Ang Thong National Marine Park is made up of 42 islands featuring lime stone massifs, tropical rainforests and deserted beaches. The Ang Thong islands rise from the sea as dramatic walls of rock soaring hundreds of metres high. Besides the many small coves and beautiful beaches, erosion has shaped some interesting formations. Particular features are Mae Ko (a beautiful beach) and Thale Nai (an emerald saltwater lake).

**Koh Tao and Koh Nang Yuan**

They're rated as the two ideal sites for diving and snorkeling in the Gulf of Thailand. The so-called "Koh Tao" and "Koh Nang Yuan" accompanied with their very own uniqueness, are the two islands where visitors define as nothing but the "must-go" islands.

**Big Buddha Temple (Wat Pra Yai)**

This temple is the home of Koh Samui's most famous landmark – the Big Buddha. Most visitors come to marvel at the sheer size and beauty of this remarkable statue at some point during their holiday. Visible from several kilometers away and even from the air when arriving on or leaving the Koh Samui island, the 12-meter tall golden image stands proud.
