

Inspired Spaces

The Westin Maui Resort & Spa is rooted in the culture of Maui and celebrates the connections to the history of the island. Each of the meeting space names reflect a story of the island.

Boasting 8,760 square feet of space, Honoapi'ilani "The bays of Pi'ilani", is named for the widely known King Pi'ilani of Maui who created peace and united the six bay areas on the west side of Maui.

The Lahaina meeting rooms, totaling 3,924 square feet, are named for important landmarks of West Maui. Mauna Komohana is the traditional name for the West Maui Mountains, seen from the mountain facing side of the resort. Lihau is the mountain ridge area before Lahaina. Lele is the traditional name of Lahaina. In a nod to the oldest school in Hawai'i, Lahainaluna High School, is Pa'upa'u which is the hill the school is on and Hālona is the stream that flows through the school.

Our Keawaki meeting rooms, with a combined total of 1,700 square feet, are named after the historical name of Lahaina Harbor. Waiokama and Waine'e take their names from the land divisions where the famed Front Street is located in.

Hōkūpa'a, A New Star

Named after the North Star, the 217-room luxury beach tower, Hōkūpa'a represents a new beginning with transformed, spacious guestrooms featuring intuitive designs and cool calming colors. Guests of Hōkūpa'a have exclusive access to The Lānai with a private bar, relaxing cocktail pools, breakfast and daily cultural experiences connecting guests to the beauty Maui.


