

TRANSPORTATION IN PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

TAXI:

The quickest and most convenient option is to use the hotel taxi that is available on request.

By calling the Front Desk on: +420 236 077 077 they will be more than happy to assist you.

When you are in the city, you can find several taxi companies available both on call and on the street. All of them have a distinctive signage. Tariffs are always listed both outside and inside the car.

SUBWAY (METRO):

Taking metro is a fast and convenient way of getting around and it also takes you to some of the important sites (train stations, Wenceslas Square, Lesser Quarter etc).

There are 3 lines: Green line (A); Yellow line (B); Red line (C)

The closest metro station to the Courtyard hotel is **Zličín (B) / Dejvická (A)**, reachable by buses from the airport – it is an easiest way to get to the Old Town and Castle Area.

BUSES AND TRAMS:

These are the most extensive public transportation networks in Prague.

The local company is called DPP. / <http://www.dpp.cz/>

The nearest bus station is right in front of the hotel – to the city center.

Tickets are to be purchased from any metro station and specialized booths (in most of the stations) and validated in the bus/tram (drivers do not carry tickets).

AIRPORT

VÁCLAV HAVEL PRAGUE AIRPORT (PRG)

PUBLIC TRANSPORT – to take public you will need a ticket for 32 CZK, which you can buy at the Public Transport Information booth at the airport.

Bus 119: Airport - Metro Line A (Dejvická)

Bus 119 runs between the Ruzyně Airport and *Dejvická* metro station (metro line A) which goes to the city center.

The bus connections run every 7 to 20 minutes and the ride takes 23 minutes.
